

NCU Prevention of Novel Coronavirus(2019-nCoV)

With the worsening outbreak of 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) in China, Central Epidemic Command Center (CECC) pointed out that the recent cumulative total of confirmed cases of the novel coronavirus continues to grow in Wenzhou, Zhejiang province, China. With the increasing number of cases reported in other countries and territories, World Health Organization (WHO) also pointed out that suspected community transmission might have occurred. Even though there has been no risk of community-acquired infections in Taiwan so far, to minimize the risk of the spread of the disease and ensure everyone's health. NCU students, professors, and staffs (everyone on campus) with a history of travel to China within 14 days after returning to Taiwan are advised to temporarily **avoid visiting public locations.** Hospitals and other healthcare facilities and to postpone nonessential medical care services or checkups.

In response to the severe situation of the outbreak of 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) in China, please attend to the following:

1. All NCU students, professors, and staffs returning from Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macao, whether having symptoms or not, please wear surgical mask and conduct self-health management for 14 days, monitoring body temperature in the morning and evening. In case of fever or flu-like symptoms (such as **fever>38°C, cough, etc.**), please dial **1922** to obtain instruction on seeking medical attention and inform health care personnel of recent travel history.

2. According to the procedure of handling confirmed cases, if NCU students, professors, and staffs **have histories of contact with positive cases**, they will be subject to compulsory quarantine (self-health management for 14 days; stay at home for quarantine, i.e., no class, no work etc.)
3. All NCU students, professors, and staffs **returning from** Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macao and having **travel history** to Wenzhou, Zhejiang provinces, China and contact tracing, they will be subject to compulsory quarantine (self-health management for 14 days; stay at home for quarantine, i.e., no class, work etc.).
4. All NCU students, professors, and staffs returning from Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macao after Jan. 20th, 2020, **MUST** to fill out the questionnaire, 「中港澳入境教職員工管理記錄表 All NCU professors, and staffs returning from Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macao record chart」。

5. All NCU students and visiting scholars returning from Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macao after Jan. 20th, 2020, **MUST** to fill out the questionnaire, 「In response to 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) in China NCU protection survey 國立中央大學因應新型冠狀病毒（嚴重特殊傳染性肺炎）防治調查」問卷。website : <https://forms.gle/tCz2GmSURNwuQhb58>.
6. To make sure all NCU students in Taiwan feel ease at school and prevent students losing their rights from returning school due to the quarantine guidelines (policy), NCU has **guidelines for students feeling ease at school in response to 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV)**. Please refer to the related attached documents.
7. All NCU students, professors, and staffs do not follow regulation of

self-health management for 14 days will be considered against Infectious Disease Control Act 48 article will be fined NT\$ 60000 to 300000 according to the same Act article 67.

8. Precautions for Campus Epidemic Prevention :

1. Wash your hands frequently, follow rules of respiratory infection hygiene and coughing, Avoid crowded and airless public area as you can.
 2. At work place: use diluted bleach solution (1:100, 500ppm) to wipe everything that you touch frequently. (table surface, doorknob and light switch etc.) to disinfection.
 3. Keep room ventilated with open windows and ventilated devices in good condition, if possible not to use air-conditioner.
 4. In general, all students, professors, and staffs no need to wear surgical masks unless go to hospitals and other healthcare facilities for medical care services or checkups. People with respiratory symptoms or chronic diseases are advised to wear a mask.
